Division of the Europe Region—Effective 9 December 2015

MasterCard has divided its Europe region into three subregions for purposes of interchange and service fees.

As of 9 December, MasterCard will re-structure the Europe region.

MasterCard EEA Subregion

 Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal (including Azores and Madeira), Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia,
 Spain (including Canary Islands, Ceuta, Melilla), Sweden, and United Kingdom (including Gibraltar).
- Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway (including Svalbard and Jan Mayen)

MasterCard Western Subregion

The MasterCard Western subregion includes the following:

- · All EEA subregion countries/territories previously stated
- Switzerland, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, and Holy See (Vatican City State), Antarctica, Greenland, Faroe Islands, Saint Barthelemy, Falkland Islands, Guernsey, Isle of Man, Jersey, Saint Helena, Ascension and Tristan Da Cunha Helena, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands

MasterCard Eastern Subregion

The MasterCard Eastern subregion includes the following:

Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Israel, Kazakhstan, Kosovo (United Nations Mission in Kosovo), Kyrgyzstan, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Russian Federation, Serbia, Tajikistan, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan.
