STEP 3

Login to Smart key application and following the instruction displayed in the Online Banking tap on the TO SIGN A NON-PAYMENT TRANSACTION option or tap on the TO SIGN AN ORDER option (TO SIGN AN ORDER in example).

STEP 4

Fill in 6-digit code and Amount values from Online Banking and tap on the „GENERATE CODE“ button to get one-time code.

Please use Token Menu **TO SIGN AN ORDER** and fill in **6-digit code 505002** and **Amount 4.40**.

STEP 5

Insert Smart key PIN.

Rewrite generated code to the sign field in the Online Banking and press the „Confirm“ button to sign your order(s).
